Alfred Zachariewicz as “en dansk Konsul for Galizien i Lemberg”

Bakgrund/Frågeställning

In 2016, a memorial plate was solemnly installed in Lviv on the house where the Honorary Consulate of the Kingdom of Denmark had functioned in the early 20th century. It was a part of the project "Lviv diplomatic". However, this fact did not lead to the emergence of profound research on Danish diplomatic institutions in Lviv or other cities of the Habsburg Empire. This presentation arose as a result of collaboration with Lviv researcher of the history of architecture, Igor Zhuk, who is currently working on the intellectual biography of Alfred Wladyslaw Zachariewicz (1871-1937). His previous research and assistance inspired my current search for the new sources and additional literature to understand the context of the emergence of the Danish consulate and the appointment of Alfred Zachariewicz as an honorary consul in 1908.

Our aim is to reconstruct the little-known page in the biography of the famous Lviv architect Alfred Zachariewicz; to present some research hypotheses and strategies for finding primary sources about the Danish honorary consulate in Lviv in the early twentieth century.
